Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizes of hook type tine carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity. Hook type blade carriages have been the same.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines may vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
